NOTICE OF INTENT

The Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT) is announcing its intent to enter into a Design-Build contract with a Design-Build Team, possessing both professional engineering design capability and qualified construction contracting capability for the construction of the I-20 Bridge Widening Project in Newton County, Mississippi.

MDOT is utilizing an accelerated project delivery method in support of the FHWA sponsored "Every Day Counts" innovation initiative. More information on the "Every Day Counts" program is available on the MDOT website.

The proposed Project consists of widening a maximum of number of bridges located on I-20 in Newton County between mile markers 115 to 132.

The anticipated contract award will be between December 2011 and January 2012. The estimated cost of this project is a maximum of \$10 Million.

A Design-Build Team will be selected for the project based on a best value selection. The selection process will consist of two phases. MDOT will issue a Request for Qualifications (RFQ), which will be evaluated to establish a short-list of proposers that will be invited to submit proposals in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP). The selection process will evaluate the ability of the Proposers to plan, design, construct, and control this Project to provide a quality product, on or ahead of schedule.

The Mississippi Department of Transportation is seeking a Design-Build Team that has the capacity to complete the project on time; is committed to quality; has proven experience in the management, design, and construction of highway projects; will bring innovative approaches to the Project; and is willing to partner with MDOT for the mutual success of the Project.

This NOTICE OF INTENT is issued to allow potential proposers an opportunity to form Design-Build Teams in anticipation of issuance of the RFQ for this project. No formal submittal is required at this time. Questions may be submitted to project website. Questions received and answers will be periodically updated on the project website. The RFQ is planned to be issued via the MDOT Website in August 2011.
