



Description – Has your Agency established and implemented a sign maintenance program that regularly addresses the new Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) minimum sign reflectivity requirements? For traffic signs to be effective in providing important information to driver, agencies should implement a sign maintenance program that regularly address the new MUTCD requirements. **The objectives** are: (1) To understand what is the MUTCD; (2) Sign Retroreflectivity Standards & Compliance Dates and Liability; (3) Basics of Signs; (4) Exempt Signs; (5) Sign Obstructions and Sign Sheeting; (6) Retroflecitivity Concepts; (7) Demonstration of Retroreflectivity; (8) Determining Good Signs vs Bad Signs.

Registration Information – This course offering through LTAP is intended primarily for local, state, federal and private agencies. Registration fee is \$25 per person. **Lunch is “on your own”**.
