Subject: Requirement of TIF Images

All new Roadway Contracts from MDOT will require submittal of TIFF images in addition to half scale prints for ROW related printing (Pre-ROW, Field Inspection Plans, Final ROW, ROW Revisions) and in addition to the CADD files for Final ROW and ROW Revisions. We do not specify how the TIFF's are created. Printed plans can be scanned or the TIFF's can be created with software of which there are several options. The best and least expensive software solution MDOT has found to perform this is PEERNET's eTIFF Print Driver. The cost of this software is shown below.

1 User License - \$95.00 USD

5 User Licenses - \$359.00 USD

10 User Licenses - \$570.00 USD

25 User Licenses - \$1,125.00 USD

50 User Licenses - \$1,825.00 USD

Attached are the revised Consultant and Plotting (See MST BatchPlot Section) chapters of the CADD Manual which explain the TIFF format and advise how to use Microstation Plot and the PEERNET Print Driver to create the TIFF images. Also attached is a revised printer.plt which you will need to use with Microstation Plot to achieve the required TIFF quality.

MDOT desires to implement the TIFF requirement into existing contracts without supplemental agreements, so be advised this is your notice to implement. Please advise me if you do not agree to implement this new procedure. If you do agree to implement, forward this information to your plans development team.
