Starting with the January 2005 letting, pay items for Agricultural Limestone and Grassing will need to include the 907 prefix in the pay item number. Those projects which have been printed will be revised as requested by Construction Division. The pay item for agricultural limestone will also need to be included on projects where the grassing pay item is used. This is a change from what was required in the past.

907-213-A Agricultural Limestone, ton or metric ton
This pay item will be used for all projects that list the individual pay items for seeding. The rates for agricultural limestone will remain the same as we use now.

907-225-A Grassing, acre or hectare
This pay item will be used for all projects that use the grassing pay item method.

907-225-B Agricultural Limestone, ton or metric ton
This pay item will be used on all projects which use the grassing pay item method. The rates to be used with 907-225-B will be 5000 lbs/acre and 5600 kilograms/hectare (2.5 tons/acre and 5 metric tons/hectare).
