Question #1: Will you provide the scope of work for the 2014 Subsurface Utility Engineering (S.U.E.) Master Contract?

Answer: The scope of work for the existing 2014 Subsurface Utility Engineering (S.U.E.) Master Contract has been posted to the MDOT website (<http://mdot.ms.gov/portal/LegalAD.aspx>).

Question #2: How much utility relocation design work are you anticipating there being for this Master Contract?

Answer: Per the RFI, “The terms of a Master Contract for a selected consultant will not exceed 3½ years with an estimated maximum contract amount of up to four (4) million dollars; however, MDOT may elect to execute a contract for a lesser not to exceed amount.”

Question #3: Will Quality Levels A through C require topographic survey using MDOT’s Survey Manual?

Answer: Yes, Quality Levels A through C will require topographic survey. All surveying performed for MDOT will be governed by the current edition of the MDOT Survey Manual unless specifically stated in writing otherwise.
