Project Description: Provide shop inspection during fabrication of structural steel bridge members, bridge appurtenances and related items as may be required for various construction projects – Statewide.

Question #1: Will only one firm be selected this time around?

Answer: Multiple consultants may be selected to execute a Master Contract with MDOT. Expressions of Interests are encouraged to be submitted from firms who perform these services.

Question #2: Item #11 request Part II of the SF 330. Please confirm that Part 1 is NOT required.

Answer: Part 1 is not required.

Question #3: Item #12 mentions that "proof of State Licensure" should not be counted in the page limitation. Does this refer to proof that responding firms are registered to do business in the state of Mississippi?

Answer: This applies to any required State license necessary to complete the project.

Question #4: With regard to Item # 8, do the Inspectors need to hold a valid Certification in ALL of the NDT methods (MT, UT, PT & RT), or is it acceptable to be certified in a minimum of one method of NDT?

Answer: At a minimum, Inspectors must be certified NDT Level II in at least one method. However, if this is the case, the firm must provide NDT Level II certified Inspectors in all test methods, and the Inspector shall inspect only the method they are certified to inspect.
