

- **What information does this site provide?**

This is **Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT)** Stimulus Reporting site. It will provide you with information on the ARRA (American Recovery and Reinvestment Act) funds allotted and distributed over five categories

- **Where does this information come from?**

This information comes from MDOT's project tracking systems and from MDOT's financial system.

- **Why are some numbers different from the federal Recovery.gov reporting site?**

There are a couple of reasons why information on this site may be different from Recovery.gov.

1. Data on this site is updated weekly. Data on the Recovery.gov site is only updated quarterly.
2. Local projects and State Aid projects are processed a little different. Local projects are contracted by a Local Public Association (LPA) and include entities such as cities or counties. State Aid projects are county projects administered by the State Aid Division. While MDOT oversees these projects, the city or county issues the actual contract and pays the contractor. The city or county then submits a reimbursement to MDOT and MDOT processes the reimbursement to obtain the federal monies. Depending on the timing of the reimbursement, monies paid to the contractor by the city or county may have been reported to Recovery.gov but not yet processed through MDOT's financial system.

Click on the report icons in the "MDOT Stimulus Reports"

- **What information does MDOT stimulus map present?**

The MDOT stimulus map displays different project categories and stimulus types on a map. You can click on the balloon to provide additional information

- **How to use the search box in the Report window?**

On the report window, type in the box and click *Find* Find | Next.

Click on *Next* to find multiple recurrences

- **Can I export the Reports to Excel and Adobe?**

Yes. You should have Excel and Adobe on your computer to access these reports.

On the report window Export

- **How to print the Reports?**

On the reports window, Select . You will need an Active-X control add-on to print the reports. An information bar will be displayed prompting a permission to install this add-on. After installing this add-on, you should be able to print the reports
